Every Sunday at 4:00 p.m. from September 28th through December 21st there will be a Choral Evensong, a Service of Readings & Music, or a Concert at the Cathedral, with the exception of Sunday October 12th (Thanksgiving Holiday).

On Sunday November 9th at 4 p.m. Capella Regalis will present their annual "For All The City" concert featuring Haydn's *Missa in angustiis* / *Mass for troubled times* with orchestra and soloists. This concert is free to the public. **Advance seat reservations recommended.**
